## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local government,
- 2 so as to change the terms for contracts for certain utility services; to provide for related
- 3 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local government, is amended
- 7 in Code Section 36-1-26, relating to terms and conditions of contracts for utility services, by
- 8 revising paragraph (1) as follows:
- 9 "(1)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, no No such contract
- shall be for a term in excess of ten years;
- 11 (B) No such contract for solar utility services or for wind utility services shall be for
- 12 <u>a term in excess of 20 years;"</u>

## SECTION 2.

- 14 Said title is further amended in Code Section 36-30-3, relating to exceptions to ordinances
- 15 of a council not to bind succeeding councils, by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (d) as
- 16 follows:
- 17 "(1)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, no No such contract
- shall be for a term in excess of ten years;
- (B) No such contract for solar utility services or for wind utility services shall be for
- 20 <u>a term in excess of 20 years;"</u>

## SECTION 3.

- 22 Said title is further amended in Code Section 36-80-17, relating to authorization to contract
- 23 for utility services, conditions, and limitations, by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (b)
- 24 as follows:
